Limitations

This warranty applies to new diesel engines that are used in school bus applications which are designated as vehicles used to transport students to and from school and school-related events. The vehicle must have warning lights and the words “**SCHOOL BUS**” written on the front and rear roof caps.

The **warranty start date** is the date of delivery of the Engine to the first user.

*Extended Major Components Warranty does not apply to B, ISB engines.

** Coverage begins on the expiration of the Base Engine Warranty and ends at the time, mile (kilometer) or hour limitation listed above, whichever occurs first, after the warranty start date.

Extended Major Components Warranty

The **Extended Major Components Parts Warranty** covers failed major components and **progressively damaged major components only**.

The **labor and material cost to repair a failed major component**, if not more than the cost of a new major component, is covered. **Labor cost for access to a failed part is not covered.**

Labor and material cost to repair any major component item according to warranty-approved salvage procedure which is progressively damaged by a warrantable failure of one or more of these major components is covered.

When the vehicle is disabled by a Warrantable Failure, **travel or towing** is covered for the first 2 years from the date of delivery, or for the duration of the warranty, whichever occurs first.

Failures of belt(s) and hoses supplied by Cummins are covered for the first year of the warranty or the duration of the coverage, whichever occurs first.

Failures resulting in **excessive oil consumption** for B series engines are covered for the duration of the coverage, 100,000 miles (160,935 kilometers) or 7,000 hours, whichever occurs first.

Non-Cummins accessories are not covered under this warranty.

Cummins branded alternators and starters are covered for the first 2 years from the date of delivery of the engine to the first user, or the expiration of the Base Engine Warranty, whichever occurs first.
